How God wants us to express *Gratitude* to Him:

- הלל Halal - to praise God boastfully, boldly, publicly, even to the point of looking foolish.
- תהלה Tehillah - a song of praise, especially a bold or public one.
- זמר Zamar – praising God with a musical instrument, with or without voices.
- תודה Todah - a thank offering, or extending hands in adoration or as a vow of praise for things not yet received.
- ידה Yadah - to lift or extend hands as an expression of praise or adoration.
- שבח Shabach - to declare praise in a loud voice (so as to sooth, still, or control anxious thoughts).
- כרך Barak - to kneel in praise, adoration, submission, or to give a blessing.
